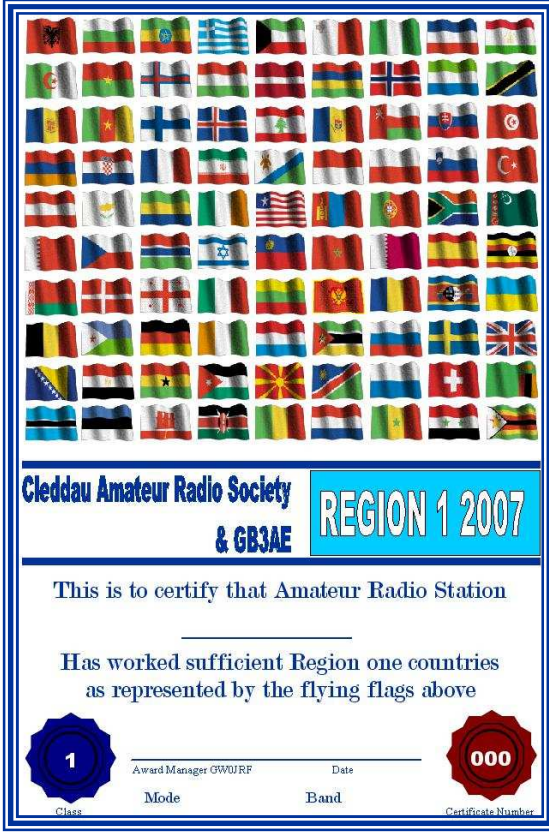

**Claims can be made on any Mode/Band or Mixed Mode/Band on repeater or internet (EchoLink) all contacts must be made after January 1st 2005.**

**Each class certificate come customized with the flags of the countries worked so it is very unlikely that any one claim class four or three will match anyone else, BUT NOT IMPOSSIBLE**

**Each certificate cost £4:00 UK \$8 US Dollars €7 Euro ¥1000 Japanese Yen, or 12 IRC, please make cheques out to Tenby Radio Repeater Group (CHEQUES UK ONLY)**
